Gangs, Violence & Exploitation unit (GVEU)

We are happy to share the GVEU with you. They are great new unit. The GVEU is a non-statutory service made up of council professionals and H&F Council-funded police officers.

Who does the GVEU help?

The GVEU is here to support young people, their families and the community. We work with young people aged 10 to 25 who are involved in gang-related activity. We also support young people who are at risk of exploitation or becoming involved in gangs.

How does the GVEU help?

The GVEU's work is built on six core principles: Participation, Community Support, Prevention, Early-intervention, Protection and Community Resilience

How do I get in touch?

The GVEU is not an emergency service. Call the police on 999 if you have an immediate concern for the wellbeing of a child or young person.

Please contact the GVEU if you have concerns about, or are affected by: gang-related activity, criminal exploitation (including knife crime and drug dealing) and sexual exploitation.


